Concerns to address

- > 50% of population lost their jobs
- > Millions fled their homes and became Internally Displaced Persons
- > There is a great need for employment assistance
- > Businesses are relocating to western regions and need a boost to start up operations once again
- > Local and relocated businesses need help hiring IDPs

Our response

- > 500 individual sessions to IDPs (women and men) on job search, resume building and preparing for interviews
- > Personal assistance of 50 IDPs to find jobs so they can support themselves and their families
- > Organize 6 employment group workshops
- > Assist at least 5 businesses (both local and relocated) with financial stipends to hire IDPs
- Support local municipal budget with 50 new working places and income taxes

Importance and Sustainability

- > IDP integration into society
- > Helping businesses relocate within the country
- > Making Ukrainian economy resilient
- > Promoting continuous development of western regions

Timeline

Duration of the project - 6 months

- > Hiring team and setting up the office: month 1
- > Individual sessions for job search: month 2-6
- > Group workshops: month 2-6
- > Assist businesses with stipends: month 3-6
- > Reporting: at project completion

Program Results

- > At least 500 people increase their knowledge and gain new skills of building a resume, job search strategies, interview preparations through the program.
- > At least 50 IDPs gain financial support, experience, and knowledge of a new job
- > At least 5 businesses receive financial assistance to cover costs of hiring IDPs
- > At least 50 jobs are created and filled in Kopychyntsi Municipality
- > At least 150 individuals receive new skills and knowledge during the offline Employment Workshops, and at least 1,200 individuals are able to join and gain similar knowledge online.

Expected impact

Through the project events IDPs resilience and confidence is strengthened and sustainable employment search practices enhanced. IDPs become financially independent and can support their families in a more sustainable way and can integrate better in their new place of residence.
