6-year-old Karolina lost both legs during the shelling of Nikopol. A rocket flew to her house. The children's room was completely destroyed, Coraline lost consciousness. When she woke up, her legs were gone. The child needs prostheses. The girl's mother is also in the hospital with leg injuries.

22-year-old Serhiy Kostyuchenko is a soldier. Two years of service. In February, he and his comrades defended Kyiv, Irpin, and Bucha. Next is the East. In May, Serhiy was blown up by a mine. He lost his right hand, the nerves in his left were severed. The legs are also injured. Serhiy needs prosthetics. Wants the best bionic prosthetic arm.

## UNBROKEN

48-year-old Oleg Gordiley lost his leg on February 25 in Kherson during the shelling of the Antonivsky Bridge. Two Russian missiles flew there. The man miraculously survived. He lost his right leg, doctors have been fighting for his left for eight months.

## All help - in one place

The First Medical Association of Lviv has **2500 beds**.

Emergency medical care, resuscitation, specialized medical care for children and adults: cardiac surgery, neurosurgery, transplantation, oncology, hematology, the main epilepsy treatment center in Ukraine.

**100 000 hospitalizations** per year.

Recently, we were made the main burn center of Ukraine.

This means that the most difficult patients who suffered both from the war and due to other circumstances, should be brought to us

## **WAR - Day-258!**

The National Rehabilitation Center "Unbroken" of the First Medical Union of Lviv is one of the main shelters for adult children who suffered from the war. Hospitals received more than **7,000** wounded, including **250 children** - with mine-explosive injuries and burns.

Today, **5,000 people need prosthetics.**

Our doctors provide assistance to the most difficult patients, those who need highly specialized medical care and rehabilitation.



## UNBROKEN

According to the Minister of Health of Ukraine, about **5,000 people** in Ukraine are waiting for prosthetics.

These are civilians, children and military personnel.

Waiting list in Europe for prosthetics for Ukrainians until **April 2023**

**40%** is the upper limb - **60%** the lower limb.

More than **25%** - double prosthetics (a person has lost 2 or more limbs)

## We have created a prosthetics service at our center

### strong points:

- a team of prosthetists ( specialist)
- cooperation with foreign prosthetists (for the training of our specialists and the provide prosthetics of Ukrainians)
- multidisciplinary team (orthopedic, prosthetist, physical rehabilitator, psychotherapist)
- motivational meetings and psychological support in the prosthetics program

### weak points:

- mobile prosthetic workshop (only 1 prosthetist can work at the same time)
- the capacity of the workshop is small, which does not meet the need - 15 prostheses per month
- lack of rehabilitation equipment
- a small number of components for collecting prostheses





## Equipment of a prosthetic workshop with a rehabilitation department

The approximate cost of the project is UAH 37,000,000.

Prosthetic equipment: 26,000,000

Rehabilitation equipment: 10,000,000

### **This will allow:**

- Reduce the time of manufacturing prostheses
- carry out repairs, adjustments and maintenance of prostheses (and such services are very necessary for patients during the entire period of wearing a prosthesis)
- manufacture and install prostheses for more than 300 patients annually

January - February 2023 - purchase of equipment  
February - March 2023 - installation of equipment,  
arrangement of the workshop and rehabilitation  
department
